

The Nancy Dix **Military** Community Achievement Award

The Community Achievement Awards are named in honor of Nancy Dix, a founding member and former president of SDMAC. In addition to her highly successful career as a partner in the law firm of DLA Piper, Nancy Dix devoted more than 25 years of public service to San Diego supporting veterans, and the military, and defense communities. She was the driving force behind the development of the annual SDMAC Achievement Awards, and it was during her tenure as President in February 2007, that the first awards were held. Nancy Dix passed away in July of 2016.

Criteria for Nomination of a *Military* Unit or Individual:

A military organization or individual that has provided outstanding support or service to the San Diego community in a non-combat related activity or role that far exceeds normal expectations, responsibilities, and accomplishments of the unit, or individual.

Along with this application, please submit:

- A **one-page summary** (PDF format) describing the nominee's exemplary service to the civilian community.
- Supporting documents (**not more than 2 pages**) may include: official recognitions, testimonials, multimedia and/or *curriculum vitae* (CV), resume of the nominee, etc.
